"The purpose of the checklist is to help body shops and their teams succeed," said Trapp. "The checklist will serve as a roadmap for businesses and employees alike. For businesses, it

provides a set of best practices. For employees, it lists the skills they need to acquire to reach the next step in their careers."

Trapp leads a working group of industry technicians, administrative staff and vendors tasked with creating a standardized apprentice checklist. The document identifies necessary skills for each role in a shop, the training and coaching required for those roles, and a methodology to assess employees' improvement. The working group expects to publish the final apprentice checklist in 2017.
