Main Responsibilities

Reporting to the General Foreman, the Electrical Foreman will be responsible for the following activities:

- Supervise the processing plant's electrical system and instrumentation in order to maintain and repair the MCC's equipment, motors and control valves and perform preventive maintenance tasks;
- Help select replacement parts according to equipment criticality;
- Work closely with the Maintenance Planner, the Mechanical Foreman and the Engineers to plan closures and establish the annual budget;
- Help obtain information from suppliers, equipment warranties, designs and replacement parts to develop the preventive maintenance system;
