- Carry out geomechanical and structural mapping of mining galleries;
- Update and analyze data collected from geomechanical monitoring instruments;
- Create, monitor, and update field test plans (cabling, shotcrete, remediation, etc.);
- Oversee grouting of the rock mass;
- Alongside the geology group, ensure the diamond drill hole database is updated;
- Determine the field test budget;
- Carry out a structural analysis of the rock mass, manage consultants, perform numerical modelling, Map3D, etc.;
- Comply with laws, regulations, and work procedures;
- Perform all other related tasks.
