Stornoway is recruiting a Mine Planning Engineer for the Renard underground mine. Reporting to the Chief Mining Engineer, the Mine Planning Engineer is responsible for the following activities.

- Develop the mining method jointly with the various stakeholders such as consultants involved in the project, and optimize it as operations progress;

- Coach and guide a team of junior production engineers as well as mining engineering interns.
