The neighborhood includes a diverse collection of premium restaurants and retail offerings, as well as the recently opened [JW Marriott Reston Station](#) — a 28-story tower with 247 hotel rooms, 94 branded condominiums, and the largest luxury banquet and event space in Northern Virginia. At the heart of the Reston Station community is Love Park, the newly added public gathering place that is anchored by Lorenzo Quinn's celebrated *Building Bridges* sculpture and provides an iconic public art experience that embodies Comstock's commitment to culture and connection.

Further west along Metro's Silver Line, the Company's Loudoun Station development continues to evolve as Loudoun County's first-ever mixed-use, transit-oriented community. The project serves as a catalyst for economic development in Loudoun County, providing high quality residential, office, retail destinations, and entertainment venues that continue to attract both local businesses and nationally recognized brands.
