The hotel is the foundation of a 28-story tower that also includes the JW Marriott Residences Reston Station, a collection of 90+ JW Marriott-branded luxury condominiums that occupy the top 14 floors. The property is setting the new standard for luxury in the D.C. region and serves as the centerpiece of *The Row at Reston Station*, Comstock's newest development phase within its award-winning Reston Station neighborhood.
