To be included or remain in the index, companies must meet a high level of performance related to a comprehensive set of sustainability metrics.

Quest Diagnostics was one of only eight Health Care Equipment and Services companies listed on the Dow Jones Sustainability North America Index and one of only eleven companies listed on the Dow Jones Sustainability World Index in the same category.

Companies are named to the DJSI based on the results of the Corporate Sustainability Assessment.
