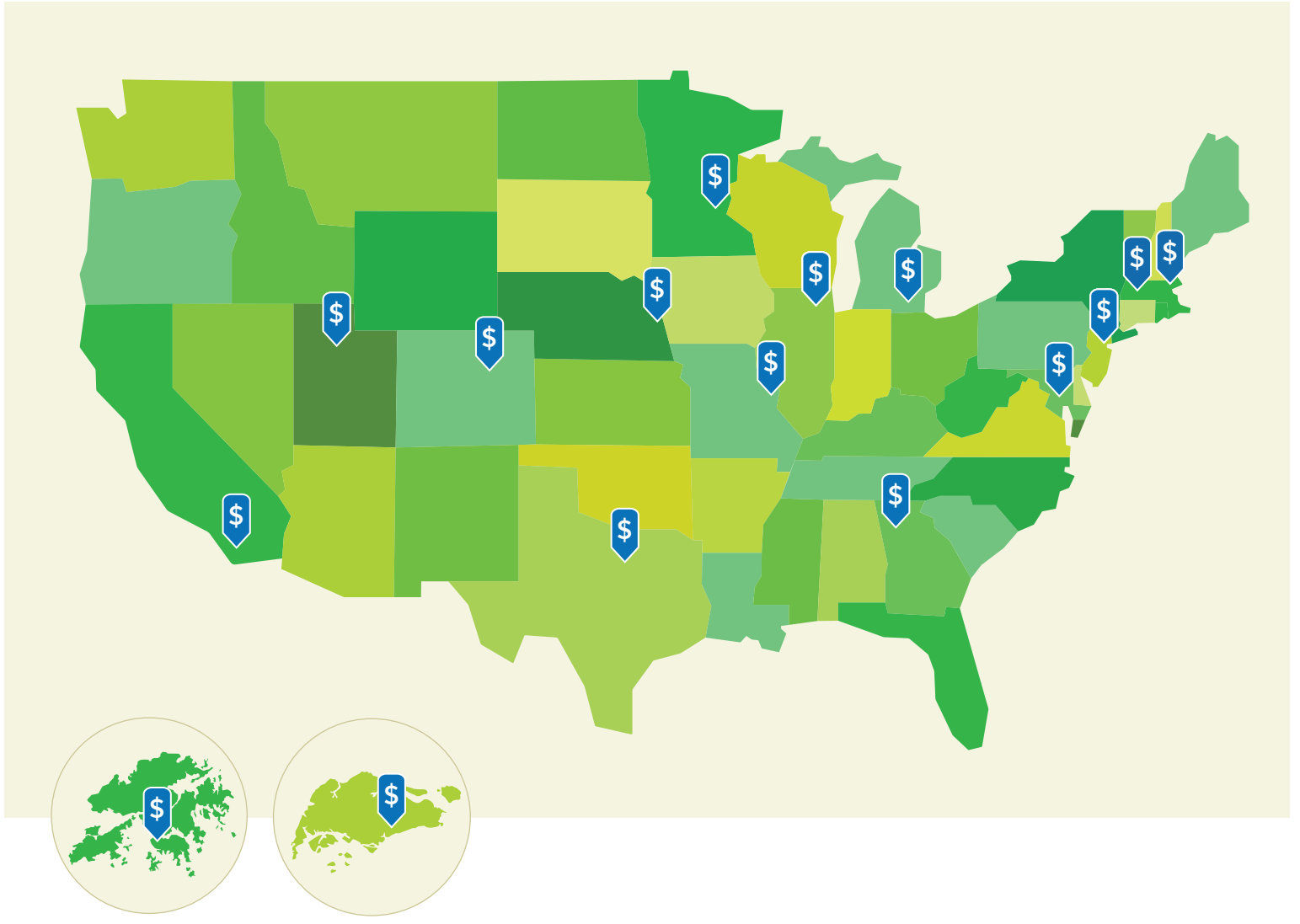


# We're Proud to Commit \$850K in Charitable Grants Across Our Communities
