

KINROSS GOLD STATEMENT:

Kinross commits US\$5.4 million to support COVID-19 response efforts in host communities

May 26, 2020 – As part of Kinross Gold’s global COVID-19 response plan, the Company has committed a total of US\$5.4 million to support host governments and communities during this challenging time.

Kinross recognizes the pandemic’s impacts on the communities where it operates, and has allocated support to all of its operating regions focused on a number of priority areas:

- **Support to healthcare institutions and hospitals, including providing emergency medical supplies, equipment and COVID-19 test kits.**
 - In Mauritania, Kinross provided equipment and supplies to upgrade the ICU facility at the main hospital in the capital city of Nouakchott.
 - In Brazil, Kinross collaborated with the Minas Gerais federation of industry to obtain ventilators for hospitals in the state, and provided test kits for the hospital in Paracatu.
 - In the Far East of Russia, the Company is supplying medical equipment to hospitals in Anadyr and Magadan.
- **Assistance to vulnerable groups, including providing food security aid, counselling and mental health support.**
 - In Alaska, Kinross supported groups that provide food security for homeless and elderly individuals and supported a hotline for families in crisis.
 - In Nevada, the Company supported programs that provide school meals at home, assists elderly individuals, and provides outreach services for families.
 - In Mauritania, Kinross donated food supplies to rural families during the Ramadan period.
- **Small business assistance to provide economic support**
 - In Nevada, Kinross supported programs which provide grants to small local businesses.
- **Medical research**
 - In Toronto, Kinross made a donation to the Sunnybrook Foundation in support of an urgent research initiative for COVID-19 treatment.

Kinross has coordinated and partnered with national and regional health authorities, local communities and NGOs to ensure its contributions are utilized in an effective and useful manner. COVID-19 has highlighted the importance of collaboration between companies, governments, communities and civil society to address a broad range of societal issues.
