Wash your hands

Wash your hands with soap and running water for at least 20 seconds.

- After coughing or sneezing
- Before eating
- After using the restroom
- When hands are visibly dirty
- Before, during and after you prepare food
- Between customer interactions/jewelry presentations



Sanitize your hands

Frequently clean them with alcohol-based hand sanitizer.

- When hands are not visibly dirty
- After using a keyboard, mouse or phone
- When soap and water is not available



Wear Gloves

Appropriate cleaning gloves must be worn based on specific tasks. The glove performance and construction characteristics must be appropriate for the task.

When to wear gloves:

- While Cleaning
- During Vendor Interactions

Types of gloves:

Cleaning Gloves

Reusable Gloves, Nitrile Powder Free, Vinyl Powder Free, and Latex Powder Free

- Intended for cleaning purposes only

Presentation Gloves

Nitrile Powder Free; Vinyl Powder Free; Latex Powder Free and Polyethylene Powder Free (Food Grade)

- Not intended for part of any cleaning protocols.

Non-cleaning Gloves

Polyethylene Powder Free (Food Grade).

- Not intended for part of any cleaning protocols.
